

## **Highlights from the July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Church Council Meeting**

1. Don Lockett updated the Council on the status of the sound system in the sanctuary and perceived issues. Possible solutions to be explored were discussed.
2. The majority of the meeting was spent reviewing the School Board Manual and making revisions. Term limits, delineation of Board and chairperson responsibilities, and Code of Conduct were the areas discussed.
3. A motion was approved to fund the sanctuary roof repairs from the Capital Appeals Fund.
4. The Personnel Committee, the staff and the Call Committee continue their efforts to employ a new Director of Family Ministries, a new Communications/Graphic person and a new Associate Pastor.
5. A letter from Synod Council was read regarding the retirement of Bishop Almen. A fund, the Lowell and Sally Almen Endowment for the ECAL Archives, has been established and TVLC was encouraged to participate. A motion was passed to contribute \$500.00 from the Unrestricted Memorial Fund to the Lowell and Sally Endowment for the ELCA Archives.
6. A card commemorating the ordination of Mateo Chavez at San Juan Bautista Lutheran Church July 29<sup>th</sup> was circulated and signed. Everyone was invited to attend this joyous event.
